Paper & Cardboard

No paper plates, towels, tissues, or napkins. No wrapping paper with foil or glitter.



Plastic Bottles & Food Containers



Screw-top caps on plastic bottles are OK.

No Styrofoam or lids.



Glass Bottles & Jars

No ceramics or glassware.



DO NOT CRUSH plastic bottles or metal cans.



Metal CANS Only

No paint or aerosol cans.

Cartons

No frozen food containers.

Recycling carts with incorrect items **WILL NOT BE SERVICED!**

How to Prepare Your Recyclables



Recyclables should be clean, dry, and empty.



NEVER bag recyclables. Place them loose in your cart.



Recycling should be at the curb by 6am on collection day.



Cardboard must be emptied, flattened, folded and placed in recycling container or stacked neatly and loosely next to it.

Pizza Box Guidelines

Pizza boxes must be clean and empty.

A **small** amount of grease is okay.
