Screw-top caps on plastic bottles OK.
No Styrofoam or lids.



Glass Bottles & Jars

No ceramics or glassware.



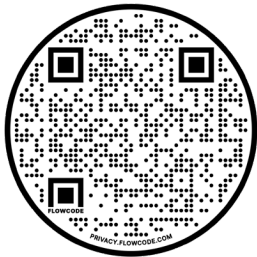
Metal CANS Only

No paint or aerosol cans.

Recyclables should be clean, dry, and empty.

NEVER bag recyclables; instead, place them loose in your cart.

Recycling should be at the curb by 6am on collection day.

Cardboard must be **emptied, flattened, folded** and placed in recycling container or stacked neatly and loosely next to it. Jammed cardboard in container may result in it being half emptied.

Pizza Box Guidelines

Pizza boxes must be clean and empty. A **small** amount of grease is okay.
