Do you know your flood risk? FEMA and the State are hosting Flood Risk Open Houses to provide residents of Burlington County, NJ with an opportunity to learn more about newly released flood maps, known as Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs). New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and FEMA representatives will be on hand to answer citizens' questions about the maps, the mapping process and flood insurance.

The Open Houses are scheduled for June 28th, 2016 at the cafeteria in the Burlington County Emergency Training Center, 53 Academy Drive, Westampton, NJ from 4:30 pm until 8:30 pm and on June 29th, 2016 at the Community Activities Room (basement) in the Burlington Township Municipal Building, 851 Old York Road, Burlington, NJ 08016 from 4:30 pm until 8:30 pm. During these times, residents will be able to locate their property on the new maps. Once residents view this information, they will have the chance to talk to members of the project team, flood insurance professionals, and local, county and state officials.

Flooding is the number one natural disaster in the United States; it is vital that property owners understand their risk and take advantage of tools or programs available to them, including flood insurance. The FIRM and the associated Flood Insurance Study (FIS) are used by flood insurance companies to determine flood insurance requirements and costs.
